## DIVERSE SYSTEMS; UNIVERSAL CONNECTIONS

**ORCID collaborates** with National IDs (like Portugal's CIÊNCIA ID), Disciplinary IDs (like INSPIRE HEP), and Proprietary IDs (like ResearcherID) to build a complete picture of research.

---

**Global Connection, Local Context:** Community-specific IDs serve vital legal and cultural roles (the "local curation"), while ORCID provides the "global connection" that allows these systems to speak to one another.

---

The model ORCID espouses is one where diverse systems work together, ensuring **no single system has to carry the burden alone.**

# THE POWER OF "ORCID *and...*"

Researcher IDs work together to build trust, save time, and combat fraud.



## ENTER ONCE, REUSE OFTEN

By integrating systems, we eliminate redundant data entry. In Portugal, the integration of CIÊNCIA ID and ORCID saves an estimated 154 hours per researcher annually.



## THE QUALITY LOOP

Combine local curation with global connection. For example, skilled staff at the German National Library (GND) curate authority files, which flow into ORCID. ORCID data then flows back to update the national file, creating a "bi-directional" loop of quality.



## ROBUST SIGNALS OF TRUST

When an external ID integrates with ORCID, it adds data with a clear source—provenance that shows who added the info. Researcher IDs have already contributed massive amounts of validated data, including 17.91M Trust Markers from Web of Science (Proprietary) and 3.64M from CIÊNCIA ID (National).
